Definition of accessory and reception events (§3.d in original ordinance)	<p>Accessory events shall be associated with the museum. Reception facility events shall be sponsored by architects.</p>	<p>Accessory events shall be associated with the museum or the Virginia AIA, so long as it is a tenant of the Center, occurring after normal museum hours and attracting more than 60 attendees. Reception facility events shall be sponsored by architects, occur after normal museum hours and attract more than 60 attendees.</p>
Number and size of events (§3.d.1-4 in original ordinance)	<p>26 special (accessory or reception) events</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One accessory event for up to 150 people • Nine events for up to 200 attendees, eight of which may be accessory or reception events • 16 accessory events for up to 75 attendees 	<p>35_ accessory and reception events</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One accessory event for up to 450 attendees • 12 events for up to 250 attendees, eight of which may be reception events • 22 accessory events for up to 75 attendees when on-street parking is required.

Noise (§3.g in original ordinance)

No amplified music, public address or loudspeaker system shall be operated outside the building.

No amplified music, public address or loudspeaker system shall be operated outside the building, except for an amplified public address system within a tent structure with side flaps lowered for one accessory event up to 450 people and 12 accessory or reception events for up to 250 people.

Exterior events (§3.e in original ordinance)

No more than 150 people can be outside at any one event

With the exception of one accessory event for up to 450 people and 12 accessory or reception events for up to 250 people, no more than 150 people shall be permitted outside of the building.
